Stage Six: Embedding and Organisational Learning



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By now you should be feeling confident that you have improved practice and can demonstrate that you are creating a safer environment for adults to engage with your organisation. You have been on a journey of learning, developing and reflecting. By this stage, you should have developed a culture where a conversation around safeguarding is normal and non-threatening.

This final Stage is about reflecting on your journey, reviewing your risk and needs assessment and action plan to see where to go next. It is also about sharing with others what has worked well and your success. You can help inspire others still on the journey and show them that there are benefits to having effective safeguarding measure in place.

This is Stage Six of Six:

- Evidence that the safeguarding culture is changing
- Equality, diversity and inclusion
- Sharing learning with others
- Number and types of referrals
